## T Cells

H. I. T. II. produce chemical messages called c tokines hich boost antibod production b B cells and acti ate macrophages. Special Helper T cells in the spleen and pmph nodes help control the responses of B cells. Here the test and help those B cells tr ing to make their antibodies more efficient.

KIL T II patrol the body checking our own cells for invaders such as iruses. Viruses are hidden ithin our cells and so cannot be directly detected by our immunes, stem. Killer T cells look for indicators on the surface of our cells hich show he they are infected by iruses and can then directly kill those cells.

**R** I I suppress other T cells.

By doing this they control the immune system and help make sure that it does not respond to self-antigens. Regulatory T cells are an important self-check—hich precent excessing eximmune reactions and reduce autoimmune disease.





### B Cells
